
Watch our 5 talented watercolor artists collaborate and create unique works of art.

-The paintings are then passed again until they come back to their original artist, who then gets 15 minutes for any touch ups.


-All artwork will be matted and placed in a sleeve to take home.




Sally is watercolorist and life-long artist. She has shown and sold her artwork at numerous art shows and galleries.
