





In addition to watching the painters, you will also be able to participate. There will be 2 community projects for everyone to contribute to using acrylic paint.



An Interview with patsy monk about, "Overcoming Adversity Through Art"

This is patsy's story.

My art really began with pain management for fibromyalgia. I couldn't tolerate the medicine so I was looking for alternatives. In 2009, I attended a Zentangle session in Rhode Island . Zentangle is a mindful meditation, prayerfulness and breathing which helps you focus away from the pain. When you do it, you don't realize what else is going on in your life. The time just goes by. Your drawings are not necessarily representational of the real world and there is no expectation for what you complete. It is an exercise in focusing. If its not moving too fast, you can Tangle it. It can be incorporated into any medium. For example, I do it in jewelry glass, origami, pen & ink even cooking. When people were getting into adult coloring books, I said let's Zentangle instead. These days, most libraries provide classes in Zentangle for free.

I have used Zentangle in many situations to help people, for example I had a classroom of students who were emotionally challenged and tended to be very loud and unruly.

By teaching them Zentangle, they were all focused and quiet during my class session.

Artist Tip of the Day

To paint an underwater scene, begin by painting the background with different shades that represent the depth. Then decide where your light source is for the sun above that filters through the water. Next, paint the sea creatures, seaweed, and any rocks you want to add. Remember to layer your elements starting with the furthest back and moving forward. The objects in the back should also be less defined just as you would do with a landscape. Don't forget to use shadows and highlights and step back from time to time to check your progress.
