Fartist tip of the Day

When doing artwork in one color (monochromatic) pay attention to composition and contrast. Decide where your focal point will be which is what you want the observer to see first. It's always fun to experiment and choosing one color is a good choice. Try extremes like minimalist or a subject that is very busy, but interesting to look at.
