## Call to Artists -

"Time and Space" is a youth exhibition for ages 8-18. The artwork will be a collage of the artist interpretation of "Time and Space". Mat board, scrap paper and instructions will be provided. They can use magazines, newspapers, calendars, or photographs to create their artwork. To create the artwork, they will be cutting out, arranging, gluing and piecing together their scene to the mat board. They can work through their layout with the scrap paper. PAC will add a mat to the artwork and then display them at the Rocky Bluff Library. We have space for 24-30 pieces of artwork and have 2 age groups. Registration and details are on our website under the Call to Artist.

Pre-registration is required. Pick-up of supplies will be in June with a drop off of artwork by June 18th at the Rocky Bluff Library.

Our third annual Photography competition is themed "Reflections". This is a juried exhibition with prizes.
