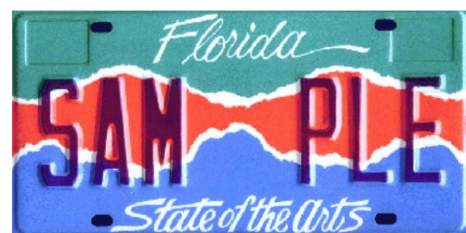

## Call To Members

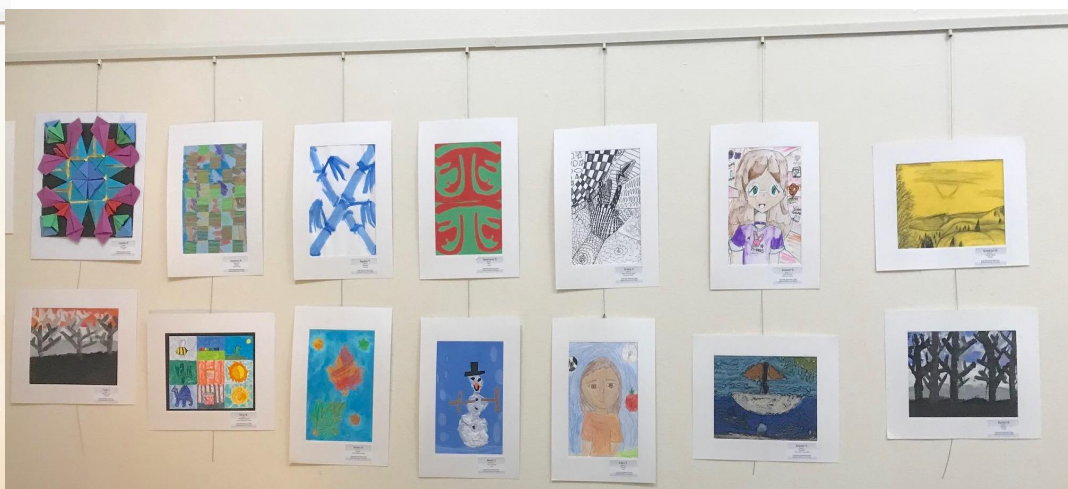
