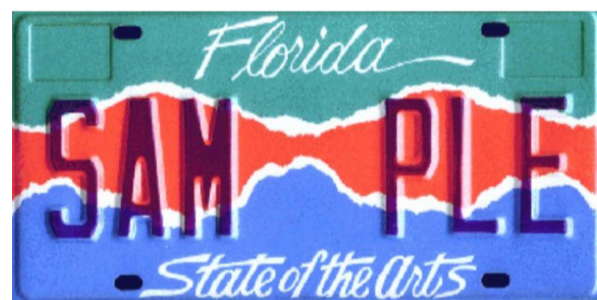
Darryl Goldman Artwork Exhibition!

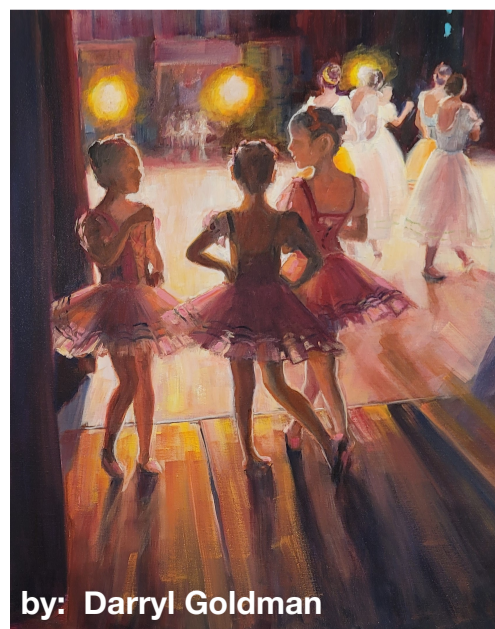
Artist's Tip
